

BY-LAW NO. 1007

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris.

WHEREAS Section 515 of The Municipal Act authorizes a municipality to construct and open a drain within the municipality and to enter upon and acquire any land for such purpose;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary and desirable that the drain hereinafter mentioned be opened and constructed and that the land for the said drain be acquired by the municipality for the purpose hereinafter set out;

AND WHEREAS the land required for the drain has been acquired by the municipality from the owners thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it and it is hereby passed and enacted by a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in Council assembled, as follows:

1. THAT all those portions of the North halves of Sections Seven and Eight in the Fourth Township and First Range East of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, required for a Public Drain and shewn outlined in Blue on a Plan of Survey prepared by Joseph Henry Wilson, of the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and sworn to by him on the 2nd day of February, 1970, be acquired and taken by the Municipality for constructing, opening and making a drain;
2. THAT ^{the} said land outlined in blue as shewn in said Plan be and is hereby opened as a public drain and dedicated to the public for its use;
3. THAT for the purposes aforesaid the officers, employees and agents of the Municipality are authorized and empowered to enter upon, acquire, break up and use the said land.

PASSED AND ENACTED by the Rural Municipality of Morris in council assembled this 11th day of December, A.D. 1970.
