

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

By-Law No. 1014

being a by-law for the purpose of granting a gratuity to
William J. Friesen of P.O.Box 162, Morris, Manitoba.

WHEREAS Section 178(1) provides that where an employee of a
municipality, while in its service

(a) becomes incapable, through illness, of discharging
his duties efficiently;

and will not, in the judgement of the council, be reasonably
provided for under section 179, the council may, grant to him
on ceasing to be employed by the municipality;

(d) an annual retiring allowance of such amount as the
majority of the members of the council consider reason-
able in the circumstances,

(ii) during the remaining years between his retirement
and the date upon which he becomes entitled to a
retirement or disability pension under the Canada
Pension Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council in regular session assembled, enacts
as follows:-


THAT, whereas William J. Friesen of Morris, Manitoba,
having been employed by the municipality for 17 years,
and due to contracting cancer of the stomach, is incap-
able of discharging his usual duties any longer;

THAT a gratuity of \$ 125⁰⁰ a month be granted to the said
William J. Friesen, until the date upon which he becomes en-
titled to Disability Benefits under the Canada Pension Plan.
