

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

By-Law No. 1016

WHEREAS Section 291(1)(c) provides that a council of any municipality may pass by-laws

(c) for preventing or regulating the firing or setting off of fireballs, squibs, firecrackers or other fireworks;

a n d

(d) for regulating or prohibiting the sale within the municipality of fireballs, squibs, firecrackers and other fireworks to any person;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed to be in the best interests of the municipality to prevent accidents or bodily harm that could be caused by the use of firecrackers and other fireworks;

NOW THEREFORE, the council of the Rural Municipality of Morris enacts as follows:

THAT the Sale of, firing or setting off of firecrackers or other fireworks, within the limits of the Rural Municipality of Morris, is prohibited;

a n d

THAT, unless special approval in writing has been obtained from the council of the municipality, the same restrictions shall apply to public functions where the firing or setting off of fireballs, squibs, firecrackers or other fireworks is contemplated. And when said approval has been obtained, proper precautionary supervision must be taken in order that the safety of persons and property be assured.

THAT any person found guilty of violating any provisions of this by-law shall be liable to a fine of not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), together with costs, and each day the violation continues, shall be a separate offence.
