

BY-LAW NO. 1029

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris.

WHEREAS Section 272 (1) of The Municipal Act authorizes a municipality to construct and open a drain within the municipality and to enter upon and acquire any land for such purpose;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary and desirable that the drain hereinafter mentioned be opened and constructed and that the land for the said drain be acquired by the municipality for the purpose hereinafter set out;

AND WHEREAS the land required for the drain has been acquired by the municipality from the owners thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it and it is hereby passed and enacted by a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in council assembled as follows:


1. THAT all those portions of River Lots Four hundred and thirty-four (434) and Four hundred and thirty-six (436) of the Parish of St. Agathe, in Manitoba, required for a Public Drain, and shewn outlined in blue on a Plan prepared by Joseph Henry Wilson, of the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and sworn to by him on the 4th day of December, 1970, be acquired and taken by the Municipality for constructing, opening and making a drain;

2. THAT the said land outlined in blue as shewn in said Plan be and is hereby opened as a public drain and dedicated to the public for its use;

3. THAT for the purposes aforesaid the officers, employees and agents of the Municipality are authorized and empowered to enter upon, acquire, break up and use the said land.

PASSED AND ENACTED by the Rural Municipality of Morris in council assembled this 14 day of July, A.D. 1972.
