

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1031

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is the owner of Tax Sale Certificate No. 12/70;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the said Municipality by a resolution on the 23rd day of September, A.D. 1971 agreed to sell the said Tax Sale Certificate to Mary Swain, of the Post Office of Sperling, in Manitoba, Housewife, for the sum of Two Hundred and Sixteen Dollars and Six Cents (\$216.06);


AND WHEREAS the said sum was the full amount of all taxes and penalties owing against the property described in the Tax Sale Certificate to the date of assignment;

AND WHEREAS the said Municipality desires to confirm the said assignment by way of a By-Law:

NOW THEREFORE THIS BY-LAW WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Tax Sale Certificate No. 12/70 be and is hereby assigned to Mary Swain, of the Post Office of Sperling, in Manitoba, for the sum of Two Hundred and Sixteen Dollars and Six Cents (\$216.06).
