

BY-LAW NO. 1032

WHEREAS "The Liquor Control Act", being Chapter L160 of the Statutes of Manitoba, 1970, including all amendments thereto, provides that when a petition is filed with the Clerk of a municipality praying for passage of a by-law approving the sale of liquor in respect of certain premises in the municipality, the council shall give first and second reading to a by-law to give effect to the petition and thereafter shall submit the by-law to a vote of the duly qualified electors of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the said "The Liquor Control Act" a petition has been received by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris requesting that a by-law be submitted to a vote of the electors of the Rural Municipality of Morris approving the issuing of licenses for the sale of liquor in:

- (a) Restaurants,
- (b) Beverage Rooms,
- (c) Dining Rooms, and
- (d) Cocktail Rooms;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris that a by-law to approve the issue of the classes of licenses hereinafter set forth be submitted to the electors of the Rural Municipality of Morris for approval in accordance with the provisions of the said Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in council assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT the issue of the following classes of licenses for the sale of liquor in respect of premises in the Rural Municipality of Morris in Manitoba, namely:

- (a) Restaurants,
- (b) Beverage Rooms,
- (c) Dining Rooms, and
- (d) Cocktail Rooms,

is hereby approved;

2. THAT this By-law shall come into force on the day it receives third reading.
