

By-Law No. 1036

being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris, relative to the acquisition of certain property for the purpose of establishing and maintaining thereon a nuisance ground.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris deems it advisable to enlarge its existing nuisance ground located on the North-East Quarter of Section Nine (9) in Township Six (6) and Range One (1) East of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba.

AND WHEREAS for said purpose the registered owner has consented to seil the required land to the Rural Municipality of Morris on condition that it do certain drainage work for him.

AND WHEREAS said drainage work has been performed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, and it is hereby enacted as By-Law No. 1036 of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in council duly assembled this day of \_\_\_\_\_, A.D. 1972, as follows:

1. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris acquire from Peter Wall Martin, Farmer, and Susie Loewen Martin, his wife, both of the Post Office of Rosenort, in Manitoba, as joint tenants and not as tenants in common, the following described land:

"All that portion of the most Southerly Two Hundred and Ninety (290) feet in perpendicular depth of the North-East quarter of Section Nine (9) in the Sixth Township and First Range East of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, lying to the West of a line drawn East of, parallel with and perpendicularly distant Eleven Hundred (1100) feet from the Western limit of said quarter section, excepting thereout all that portion thereof contained within the limits coloured "Pink" on a Plan registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 5785".

2. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris establish and maintain a nuisance ground on the above-described property.

3. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to this By-Law.
