

BY-LAW NO. 1043

Being a By-law of The Rural Municipality/
~~Town~~ of MORRIS ~~approving~~/disapproving
a request for the establishment of
the proposed Morris River Watershed
Conservation District.

WHEREAS:

- a) It is proposed to create a watershed conservation district to be known as the Morris River Watershed Conservation District;
- b) The Minister has, pursuant to Section 4(1) of The Watershed Conservation District Act, submitted to the Municipality for its approval or disapproval a request that the proposed district be established; and
- c) Section 4(2) of the said Act states:

"The Council of each municipality to which a request has been submitted shall consider it, and shall, by by-law, approve or disapprove it within sixty days after it has been submitted to it; and the council shall notify the minister of its decision thereon."

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Rural Municipality/
~~Town~~ of MORRIS, in open meeting duly assembled in its chambers in MORRIS, Manitoba, HEREBY ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) The Council hereby ~~approves~~/disapproves of the establishment of the proposed Morris River Watershed Conservation District and ~~approves~~/disapproves of the Municipality's inclusion in said District.
- 2) The Secretary-Treasurer is authorized and instructed to notify the Minister of the Council's ~~approval~~/disapproval and to submit a copy of this By-law to him.
