WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris deems it advisable to purchase certain equipment to better carry out its road and drainage maintenance and construction program;

AND WHEREAS Powell Equipment Co. Ltd. of Winnipeg has offered to sell to the municipality the following equipment:


One new Caterpillar Model 140 MOTOR GRADER ^{ser. # 24R527} Arr. #7D6080 includes diesel engine with 24 volt electric starting, alternator, glow plugs, fuel priming pump, muffler, dry type air cleaner with primary and safety elements, DH2 steel cutting edges, hydraulic steering booster, four wheel power boosted brakes, parking brake, Direct Drive with ROPS mounting including seat belt and other accessories as stated in Invoice R3T 1L8, dated April 27, 1973;

AND WHEREAS the price of \$35,957.25, sales tax included, is considered a fair and reasonable one,


NOW THEREFORE be it enacted that the Rural Municipality of Morris purchase from Powell Equipment Co. Ltd. the above described Motor Grader at and for the price of \$35,957.25.

THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be empowered to do all acts necessary to complete the purchase of said equipment.
