

BY-LAW NO. 1057

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris relating to the opening of a public road in River Lots 501 and 503 of the Parish of Ste. Agathe.

WHEREAS Section 209 (1)(a) of The Municipal Act, Statutes of Manitoba 1970 Cap M225 enacts as follows:

"209 (1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), the council of a municipality may pass by-laws (a) for opening, establishing, making, preserving, maintaining, improving, constructing, repairing, widening, or enlarging, any highway."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris deems it necessary and advisable to open a public road on the land described as follows:

All those portions of River Lots 501 and 503 of the Parish of Ste. Agathe, in Manitoba, which lots are shown on a plan of Special Survey of part of said Parish, registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 3599 shown as Public Road and outlined in pink on a plan prepared by Joseph Henry Wilson of the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba Land Surveyor and sworn to by him on the 14th day of February, 1974.

AND WHEREAS Jean Leon Quimet is the owner of the above described land and has agreed to sell it to the Municipality for the sum of \$1.00.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in open session assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the Rural Municipality of Morris purchase from Jean Leon Quimet for the sum of \$1.00 the following described land:

All those portions of River Lots 501 and 503 of the Parish of Ste. Agathe, in Manitoba, which lots are shown on a plan of Special Survey of part of said Parish, registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 3599 shown as Public Road and outlined in pink on a plan prepared by Joseph Henry Wilson of the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba Land Surveyor and sworn to by him on the 14th day of February, 1974.

and open upon it a road dedicated to the public use.

2. That the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to this by-law.

3. That before the within by-law comes into force it shall be approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.
