

BY-LAW NO. 1058

Being a By-Law of the Rural
Municipality of Morris, relative
to the disposition of certain lands.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is the registered owner
of the following described land:

"All that portion of the most Northerly One Hundred and Thirty feet in perpendicular width of River Lot Four hundred and Thirty-two of the Parish of Sainte Agathe, in Manitoba, according to a plan registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 4121, which lies to the West of the Western limit of the land taken for a public road, as same is shewn coloured pink on a plan registered in the said office as no. 4116. Subject to the reservations as to mines and minerals as set forth in the transfer registered in said office as A 14941."

AND WHEREAS YVES GUILLOU, of the Post Office of Aubigny,
in Manitoba, farmer, has offered to purchase the above described land at
and for the sum of TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS;

AND WHEREAS the said land is no longer required for the
purposes of the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and it is hereby enacted as by-
law no. of the Rural Municipality of Morris in council duly assembled,
as follows:

1. THAT The Rural Municipality of Morris sell and convey the following
described land:

"All that portion of the most Northerly One Hundred and Thirty feet in perpendicular width of River Lot Four hundred and Thirty-two of the Parish of Sainte Agathe, in Manitoba, according to a plan registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 4121, which lies to the West of the Western limit of the land taken for a public Road, as same is shewn coloured pink on a plan registered in the said office as No. 4116. Subject to the reservations as to mines and minerals as set forth in the transfer registered in said office as A 14941."

to YVES GUILLOU, of the Post Office of Aubigny, in Manitoba, farmer, for
the sum of TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS.

2. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and are hereby
authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to this
by-law.
