

BY-LAW NO. 1060

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris submitted to its duly qualified electors a by-law for the approval of the issuing of licenses for the sale of liquor in - (a) restaurants
(b) beverage rooms
(c) dining rooms, and
(d) cocktail rooms.

on the 25th day of October, 1972;

AND WHEREAS said by-law did not receive the approval of a majority of the duly qualified electors of the Rural Municipality of Morris ;

AND WHEREAS ^{Sub}Section 262 (7) of the Liquor Control Act, being Chapter L 160 of the Revised Statutes of Manitoba, provides as follows:

'262(7) Where the result of a vote on a liquor referendum held in a rural municipality shows that the vote
(a) in an unincorporated village; or
(b) in a municipal ward;
that is located within the rural municipality is contrary to the overall vote in the rural municipality, the council of the rural municipality, if it is satisfied that the unincorporated village or municipal ward because of its peculiar location or flow of traffic because of highways, is isolated or generally disconnected from the rest of the rural municipality, the rural municipality may, subject to the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council
(c) if a by-law has been passed, pursuant to the vote held in the rural municipality amend the by-law to exempt that village or ward from the by-law, or
(d) pass a by-law approving or disapproving, as the case may be, the issue of licences as indicated by the vote of the resident electors of the village or ward."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris deems it advisable to pass a by-law approving the issue of certain licenses for the sale of liquor in respect of premises in Ward 6 of the Rural Municipality of Morris in Manitoba in view of the result of the vote of the qualified electors of Ward 6 held on the 25th day of October, 1972.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council of the Rural Municipality of Morris in open council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT the issue of the following classes of licenses for the sale of liquor in respect of premises in Ward 6 in the Rural Municipality of Morris, in Manitoba, namely: (a) restaurants,
(b) beverage rooms,
(c) dining rooms, and
(d) cocktail rooms .

is hereby approved.

2. THAT this by-law shall come into force on the day it receives the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council .
