

BY-LAW NO. 1061

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in the Province of Manitoba, for closing the highway hereinafter described and selling and conveying the highway closed.

WHEREAS Section 209 (1) (c) and (1) (d) of The Municipal Act, Statutes of Manitoba 1970, Cap. 100, and amendments thereto, enacts as follows:

209 (1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), the council of the municipality may pass by-laws

(c) for closing any highway; or

(d) for selling and conveying to any person, or vesting in in the municipality the title to the land upon which is situated any highway that has been closed;

AND WHEREAS Section 209 (2) (a) and (2) (b) of The Municipal Act, Statutes of Manitoba 1970, Cap. 100, and amendments thereto, enacts as follows:

209 (2) Before passing a by-law under clause (c) or (d) of subsection (1)

(a) a notice of the proposed by-law shall be published at least once a week for four successive weeks, and a similar notice shall be posted up for at least one month in at least four of the most public places in the immediate neighbourhood of the highway; and

(b) the council shall hear in person, or by agent, any person who claims that his land will be prejudicially affected by the by-law and who applies to be heard;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris deems it necessary and advisable to close the highway hereinafter described and sell and convey the portions closed;

AND WHEREAS a notice of this by-law was published at least once a week for four consecutive weeks in The Carillon News, a newspaper published in the Town of Steinbach, in the Province of Manitoba, having a circulation within the limits of the said Rural Municipality of Morris, in which the said land is situated, and a similar notice was posted up for at least one month in four of the most public places in the immediate neighbourhood of the said highway;

AND WHEREAS no person applied to be heard by the said Council claiming that his land would be prejudicially affected by the said by-law;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the said Rural Municipality of Morris, in open session assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris close the highway in the said Rural Municipality of Morris hereinafter described and sell and convey the portion closed, except mines and minerals, to FRANK WIENS and ROBERT FRANK WIENS, both of the Post Office of Domain, in Manitoba, Farmers, each an undivided one-half interest, at and for the sum of Six Hundred and Seventy-five (\$675.00) Dollars;

The said highway to be closed is described as follows:

"All that portion of a Highway lying immediately to the North of River Lot Four Hundred and Eighty (480) of the Parish of Ste. Agathe, in Manitoba, according to a plan of same registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 4122, and lying to the West of a Public Road as same is shown on a plan registered in the said Office as No. 4117."

2. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to this by-law.

3. THAT before the within by-law comes into force it shall be approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.
