

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1070

Being a by-law respecting an Agreement between

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

and the Minister of Municipal Affairs for the provision of Planning Service to the said Municipality.

WHEREAS, Section 6 of The Planning Act authorizes the Municipality to request and enter into a Planning Service Agreement with the Minister.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Municipality enter into such Agreement in order to obtain advisory planning assistance in any or all of the matters and services described in Section 6 of The Planning Act.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the said Municipality enacts as follows:

- (1) That the Rural Municipality of Morris does herewith enter into an agreement with the Minister of Municipal Affairs pursuant to the provision of The Planning Act and on the terms set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

SCHEDULE "A"

An Agreement between
The Minister of Municipal Affairs
and

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

pursuant to the provisions of
The Planning Act.

WHEREAS the Municipality has requested the Minister to assist it in those matters and services described in Section 6 of The Planning Act which are applicable to the development of a suitable Planning programme.

AND WHEREAS the Minister has agreed to make such services available.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipality, in consideration of said Planning Services being provided, agrees to pay to the Province of Manitoba, for assistance provided in any or all of the matters or services mentioned in Section 6 of The Planning Act, on March 31st of each year following the completion of each full year of agreement, a sum of 30 ¢ per capita (population to be determined by the Director of Planning), to be payable as follows:

First payment on or before March 31, 1976

Second payment on or before March 31, 1977

Third payment on or before March 31, 19


Fourth payment on or before March 31, 19

Fifth payment on or before March 31, 19

In the event that the Municipality shall fail to pay this amount the Provincial Treasurer may take the amount thereof from any amount payable to the Municipality by the Province.

The Agreement shall continue in effect for a period of two years, commencing on the first day of September 1975
