

BY-LAW NO. 1073.

Being a by-law of The Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the disposition of certain property.

WHEREAS THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS has received an offer to sell the residence formerly occupied by its Secretary-Treasurer;

AND WHEREAS the residence is no longer required by the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS the offer is deemed fair and reasonable;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and it is hereby enacted by the council of THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS, duly assembled, as follows:

1. THAT THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS enter into a contract for the sale of the following described land:

"Lot Twenty-seven and the East half of Lot Twenty-eight, which lots are shewn on a plan of survey of part of the Town of Morris, in Manitoba, registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office, Morris Division, as No. 23."

to UKE ITO, Restaurant Owner, and LILLIAN ITO, his wife, both of the Town of Morris, in Manitoba, as joint tenants and not as tenants in common, and it does hereby sell and convey unto UKE ITO, Restaurant Owner, and LILLIAN ITO, his wife, both of the Town of Morris, in Manitoba, as joint tenants and not as tenants in common, the following described land:

"Lot Twenty-seven and the East half of Lot Twenty-eight, which lots are shewn on a plan of survey of part of the Town of Morris, in Manitoba, registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office, Morris Division, as No. 23."

at and for the price of TWENTY THOUSAND (\$20,000.00) DOLLARS.

2. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to this by-law.
