

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY LAW NO. 1074.

Being a By Law of The Rural Municipality of Morris to amend  
By Law No. 1026.


WHEREAS By Law No. 1026, being a By Law providing for the  
creating of a Machinery and Equipment Replacement Reserve Fund,  
was enacted the twenty-fourth day of April, A. D., 1972, and  
duly approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs;


AND WHEREAS the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris  
deems it expedient and in the best interest of the corporation  
to amend the said By Law No. 1026;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris,  
in open Council assembled, enacts as follows:

- I. That Clause 1 of By Law No. 1026 be repealed and the  
following substituted therefor:
  - "1. That a special rate of ~~Two~~ (2) Mills on the dollar be and  
hereby is levied annually for a period of Five (5) years,  
commencing in the year A. D. 1976 upon the assessed value  
of all the rateable property in the corporation liable  
therefor to produce an amount which shall be deposited  
annually in the reserve fund created hereby, and form  
part thereof;"
  2. That this By Law shall come into force and take effect  
upon the date on which it receives the approval of the  
Minister of Municipal Affairs.

in open Council assembled, at the Town of Morris, this 27th
