

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris.

WHEREAS Section 272(1) of The Municipal Act authorizes a municipality to construct and open a drain within the municipality and to enter upon and acquire any land for such purpose;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary and desirable that the drain hereinafter mentioned be opened and constructed and that the land for the said drain be acquired by the municipality for the purpose hereinafter set out;

AND WHEREAS the land required for the drain has been acquired by the municipality from the owner thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it and it is hereby enacted as by-law No. 1079 of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in council duly assembled as follows:

1. THAT all those portions of the South half of Sections Nineteen, Twenty and Twenty-one, in the Sixth Township and First Range West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, required for a Public Drain and shewn coloured Blue on a Plan of Survey, prepared by Joseph Henry Wilson, of the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and sworn to by him on the 30th day of July, 1975, be acquired and taken by the Municipality for constructing, opening and making a drain.
2. THAT all those portions of the North Half of Sections Four, Five and Six, in the Sixth Township and First Range West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, required for a Public Drain and shewn coloured Blue on a Plan of Survey, prepared by Joseph Henry Wilson, of the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and sworn to by him on the 30th day of July, 1975, be acquired and taken by the Municipality for constructing, opening and making a drain.
3. That the said lands coloured Blue as shewn in said plan, be and are hereby opened as a public drain and dedicated to the public for its use.
4. THAT for the purposes aforesaid, the officers, employees and agents of the Municipality are authorized and empowered to enter upon, acquire, break up and use the said land.
5. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to the within by-law.
