

BY-LAW NO. 1092.

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to establish the Sperling Community Centre District.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 432 (1) of The Municipal Act, C100, S.M. 1970, a council of a municipality may, among other things, establish community centres;

AND WHEREAS it is the intention of the council of the Rural Municipality of Morris to establish several community centre districts within its boundaries;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient at this time to designate the area and boundaries of the various community centre districts so as to ultimately proceed to the erecting, maintaining and regulating of various community centres;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and it is hereby enacted as a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in council duly assembled as follows:

1. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris hereby establishes "The Sperling Community Centre District" which shall be comprised of those lands described in Schedule "A" to this by-law.
2. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to this by-law.
