

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY LAW NO. 1097.

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS TO PROVIDE FOR THE MAKING OF GRANTS OF MONEY.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, S.M. 1970, C.100-M225, Section 372, et seq., provides that the council of any municipality may pass by-laws for making grants of money to certain organizations;

AND WHEREAS the council of The Rural Municipality of Morris deems it expedient and in the best interest of the corporation to make grants of money to certain organizations in the year 1977;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS, DULY ASSEMBLED IN OPEN COUNCIL, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. THAT the council of The Rural Municipality of Morris be and is hereby authorized to make grants of money in the year 1977 to the organizations and in the amounts here-under set out:
