

BY-LAW NO. 1103

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris, relative to the acquisition of certain lands.

WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 196(2) (a) of The Municipal

Act:

"196(2) A municipality may by by-law

(a) acquire by lease, purchase, gift or otherwise, land or an interest therein that the council may deem necessary for the purposes of the municipality."

AND WHEREAS the owner of the following described land:

"All that portion of the North-East Quarter of Section Six in the Sixth Township and First Range East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, described as follows: Commencing at a point on the Eastern limit of said Quarter Section distant Northerly thereon Four hundred feet from the South-East corner thereof, thence Westerly parallel to the Southern limit of said Quarter Section, Two Hundred and Seventy-five feet, thence Southerly parallel to the Eastern limit of said Quarter Section, One Hundred and Fifty-six feet, thence Easterly parallel to the Southern limit of said Quarter Section to the Eastern limit of said Quarter Section, thence Northerly along said Eastern limit to the point of commencement."

wishes to donate said lands to the Rural Municipality of Morris;

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris deems it advisable to accept the gift in order that it might at some future date construct a Community Centre on said lands;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and it is hereby enacted as by-law no. 1103 of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in council duly assembled as follows:

1. That the Rural Municipality of Morris accept the gift of the following described lands:

"All that portion of the North-East Quarter of Section Six in the Sixth Township and First Range East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, described as follows: Commencing at a point on the Eastern limit of said Quarter Section distant Northerly thereon Four Hundred feet from the South-East corner thereof, thence Westerly parallel to the Southern limit of said Quarter Section, Two Hundred and Seventy-five feet, thence Southerly parallel to the Eastern limit of said Quarter Section, One Hundred and Fifty-six feet, thence Easterly parallel to the Southern limit of said Quarter Section to the Eastern limit of said Quarter Section, thence Northerly along said Eastern limit to the point of commencement."

from the owner thereof.

2. That the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to this by-law and to vest title to said land in the name of the Rural Municipality of Morris.
