BY-LAW NO. 1110

BEING A By-Law Relative to Ratification of an Agreement Between Municipal Corporations and a Contractor Charged With the Enforcement of a Dog Control By-Law.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, being Chapter M225 of The Continuing Consolidation of Manitoba Statutes, Section 5(3)(g) provides as follows:

"5 (3) (g) Every municipality . . . may . . . enter into an agreement with any other municipality or with any other person or with both a municipality and a person, for the doing jointly with that municipality or person of any act or thing that it has power to do within the municipality;"

AND WHEREAS the RURAL MUNICIPALITY of MORRIS has entered into an Agreement with Fred Ward, of the Postal District of Emerson, in Manitoba, for the enforcement of its dog control by-law, which agreement contemplates expenditures for capital costs and monthly expenditures which will be paid partly by other municipal corporations;

AND WHEREAS it is desired to ratify and confirm the said Agreement, and to expend moneys of the Municipality in connection therewith;

THEREFORE NOW BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AS A BY-LAW of the RURAL MUNICIPALITY of MORRIS, in Council duly assembled, as follows:

1. THAT the Agreement, marked "Schedule A", attached to this By-Law, and forming a part thereof, be ratified and confirmed.
2. THAT the Reeve/Mayor and the Secretary-Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to execute said Agreement on behalf of the Municipality.
3. THAT payment be made to the Contractor named in said Agreement from the date on which he commenced his duties on behalf of the Municipality.
