

By-Law No. 1125.

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris;

WHEREAS the Kane Community Centre Inc. is the registered owner of the following described land:

Parcel One: The most Easterly Four Hundred and Sixty-six and seven-tenths feet in width of the most Westerly One Thousand, One Hundred and Thirteen and seven-tenths feet in width of the most Southerly Four Hundred and Sixty-six and seven-tenths feet in depth of the South West Quarter of Section Six, in Township Five, and Range Two, West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, excepting thereout all mines and minerals.

Parcel Two: The most Easterly Three Hundred and Forty-seven feet in width of the most Westerly Five Hundred and Forty-seven feet in width of the most Northerly One Hundred feet in depth of the most Southerly Two Hundred and Fifty feet in depth of the South West Quarter of Section Six, in Township Five, and Range Two, West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, excepting thereout all mines and minerals.

Parcel Three: The most Easterly One Hundred feet in width of the most Westerly Six Hundred and Forty-seven feet in width of the most Northerly Two Hundred and Seventy-five feet in depth of the most Southerly Four Hundred and Twenty-five feet in depth of the South West Quarter of Section Six, in Township Five, and Range Two, West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, excepting thereout all mines and minerals.

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris has offered to buy the above described land from the Kane Community Centre Inc. at and for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted and it is hereby enacted as By-Law No. 1125 of the Rural Municipality of Morris as follows:

1. That the Rural Municipality of Morris purchase the following described land:

Parcel One: The most Easterly Four Hundred and Sixty-six and seven-tenths feet in width of the most Westerly One Thousand, One Hundred and Thirteen and seven-tenths feet in width of the most Southerly Four Hundred and Sixty-six and seven-tenths feet in depth of the South West Quarter of Section Six, in Township Five, and Range Two, West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, excepting thereout all mines and minerals.

Parcel Two: The most Easterly Three Hundred and Forty-seven feet in width of the most Westerly Five Hundred and forty-seven feet in width of the most Northerly One Hundred feet in depth of the most Southerly Two Hundred and fifty feet in depth of the South West Quarter of Section Six, in Township Five, and Range Two, West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba excepting thereout all mines and minerals.

Parcel Three: The most Easterly One Hundred feet in width of the most Westerly Six Hundred and Forty-seven feet in width of the most Northerly Two Hundred and Seventy-five feet in depth of the most Southerly Four Hundred and Twenty-five feet in depth of the South West Quarter of Section Six, in Township Five, and Range Two, West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, excepting thereout all mines and minerals.

from the Kane Community Centre Inc. at and for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.

2. That the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to this by-law.
