

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY LAW NO. 1132.

BEING A BY LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS TO AUTHORIZE THE CANCELLATION OF TAXES AND DEBTS OWING TO THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS Section 885 of The Municipal Act provides authority to cancel in whole or in part any taxes or any debt of moneys owing to the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris considers that it is in the best interest of the Municipality to cancel the hereinafter specifically mentioned taxes and debts owing to the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS, DULY ASSEMBLED IN OPEN COUNCIL, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the Real Property, and Leasehold taxes described in Schedule "A" annexed hereto amounting to the total sum of 0\$2,324.81;

THAT the Business Taxes described in Schedule "B" annexed hereto amounting to the total sum of 0\$126.06;

THAT the Miscellaneous Accounts described in Schedule "C" annexed hereto amounting to the total sum of 0\$396.52, which said schedules are hereby made a part of the By Law, be and the same are hereby cancelled.

2. THAT this By Law, together with evidence of Bona fides, be submitted to the Minister forthwith, and when the said By Law is approved and takes effect, that all things be done and entries made to give effect to the provisions of same.

3. THAT no entry of any cancellation effected by this By-Law shall be made in the records of the municipality until the Minister of Municipal Affairs has certified this By Law.

4. THAT this By Law shall come into force and take effect when approved by the Minister.
