

BY-LAW NO. 1135.

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris for closing a highway, pursuant to Section 209 of The Municipal Act.

WHEREAS Section 209 of The Municipal Act provides, in part, as follows:

(1) Subject to subsections (2), (3) and (4), the Council of a Municipality may pass by-laws

(c) for closing any highways;

AND WHEREAS a Plan of Subdivision is to be registered by or on behalf of the Rosenort Development Corporation Limited affecting the lands taken for the following described highway and providing for a change of name of the said highway from Goossen Drive to Canola Drive;

NOW THEREFORE be it and it is hereby passed and enacted as a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris in Council duly assembled, as follows:

1. THAT all that portion of the public highway described as follows:

The most Westerly One Hundred feet of all that portion of the North West Quarter of Section Five in the Sixth Township and First Range, East of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, taken for Goossen Drive, contained within the limits bordered Pink on a Plan registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 9962;

be and the same is hereby closed.

2. THAT the proper officers of the Municipality are hereby authorized and directed to do all acts and execute all documents required for the purpose of implementing this by-law.
