

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY LAW NO. 1136.

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS TO PROVIDE FOR THE PARTICIPATION OF THE RURAL OF MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN MUTUAL FIRE AID.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act authorizes the councils of all municipalities to enter into agreement with other municipalities for the use of fire fighting equipment or any of it within their Mutual Aid District;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS, DULY ASSEMBLED IN OPEN COUNCIL, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris Fire Departments be authorized to leave the limits of the municipality or fire area, at the discretion of the Chief and under the direction of the Mutual Aid Area Fire Co-ordinator, to respond to calls for assistance from other Municipal Fire Departments authorized to participate in the Mutual Aid Area Mutual Fire Aid System or any other Area Mutual Fire Aid System on a reciprocal basis.

2. THAT in the case the provisions of this By-Law conflicts with the provisions of any other By-Law, the provisions of this By-Law shall prevail.
