

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY LAW NO. 1140.

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS TO FIX THE REMUNERATION OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, S.M. 1970, C.100, M225, Part III, Sections 154 (2), and 167, provides as follows:

Section 154 (2) Every municipality may, by by-law, appoint a Secretary-Treasurer, who may be paid an annual salary.

Section 167 - The council shall by by-law provide for the payment of all municipal officers and employees and shall fix the remuneration of any officer or employee whose remuneration is not fixed by an Act of the Legislature.

AND WHEREAS The Rural Municipality of Morris has in its employe a Secretary-Treasurer, and other employees for whom it is necessary to fix remuneration as aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS, DULY ASSEMBLED IN OPEN COUNCIL, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the remuneration of officers and employees of the municipality be and is hereby fixed as follows:

2. THAT first time employees, hired on hourly basis, shall have a starting wage of 50¢ an hour less.

3. THAT increases of 25¢ per hour be given, after 3 months of satisfactory service, and a final 25¢ per hour increase be given after an additional 3 months of satisfactory service.

4. THAT all employees be entitled to compassionate leave of three days, in the event of death in the immediate family.


5. THAT By Law No. 1126 is hereby repealed.

6. THAT this by-law shall be deemed to have been in force on, from and after the sixth day of January, A.D., 1980.
