

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to provide for the establishment of a joint community centre district with the Town of Morris; for the fixing of the boundaries of the district; the levying of a special tax; and entering into an agreement with the Town of Morris.

WHEREAS the Town of Morris has within its boundaries established a community centre;

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is desirous of entering into an agreement with the Town of Morris to create a joint community centre district which will include the lands contained in the Town of Morris and the lands of the Rural Municipality of Morris as described in paragraph 2 of this by-law;

AND WHEREAS subsection 433(1) of The Municipal Act, being chapter 100 of the Statutes of Manitoba, 1970 (chapter M225 of the Continuing Consolidation of the Statutes of Manitoba) provides as follows:

433(1) The councils of two or more joining or neighbouring municipalities on behalf of the municipalities or parts thereof to be included in the joint community centre district, may by by-law provide for

- (a) the establishment of a joint community centre district;
- (b) the fixing of the boundaries thereof;
- (e) jointly with the other municipalities the councils may pass by-laws as aforesaid, acquiring land, either within or outside the limits of any of the municipalities and for establishing or erecting and maintaining thereon, and regulating a community centre for the public use of the residents of the municipalities or portions thereof;
- (g) the levying of a special tax, as provided in subsection (4);
- (h) the respective municipalities entering into an agreement setting forth the terms agreed upon, including the appointment of a joint community centre district board, as provided in subsection (2).

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris, duly assembled, enacts as a by-law as follows:

1. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris establish a joint community centre district with the Town of Morris, to be known as The Joint Morris Community Centre District.

2. THAT the lands of the Rural Municipality of Morris to be included in the joint community centre district are as follows:

- a) Sections 1 to 3, inclusive, 10 to 15 inclusive, 22 to 27 inclusive, 35 and 36, all in Township 4 and Range 1, West;
- b) Sections 1 and 2 in Township 5 and Range 1, West;
- c) Sections 3 to 10 inclusive, 15 to 22 inclusive, 27 to 33 inclusive, all in Township 4 and Range 1, West; East;

d) Sections 4 to 6 inclusive, South Half of Section 9, all of Section 10, South East Quarter of Section 24 all in Township 5 and Range 1, East;

e) Sections 1 to 11, both inclusive, the South Half and the North West Quarter of Section 12, Sections 14, 15, 22 and 23, the South West Quarter of Section 30, all in Township 5 and Range 2, East;

f) River Lots 299 to 429, both inclusive, 338 to 400, both inclusive, 406 and 408, all in the Parish of Sainte Agathe;

g) All railway, pipeline and grant property within the limits of the above described land.

3. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris enter into an agreement for that purpose with the Town of Morris, which agreement is shown as Schedule "A" to this by-law.

4. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris during the currency of the agreement referred to in paragraph 3 hereof raise annually by a special levy on all taxable property as set out in paragraph 2, EIGHTEEN (18) PER CENT of the annual moneys required to maintain and operate the community centre.

5. THAT the levy to be imposed shall be with respect to the maintenance and operation of the skating rink only.
