

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1147/81. *W*

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to provide for entering into an agreement with Felicien ~~Adelbart~~ Bouchard, of the Post Office of Aubigny, in Manitoba, respecting the subdivision of certain lands within the Municipality.

WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris deems it convenient and in the public interest to enter into an agreement with Felicien ~~Adelbart~~ Bouchard respecting the subdivision of certain lands within the Rural Municipality of Morris;

AND WHEREAS the proper officers of the Rural Municipality of Morris negotiated the terms of the within agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris assembled enacts as a by-law as follows:

1. That the Rural Municipality of Morris enter into an agreement with Felicien ~~Adelbart~~ Bouchard, of the Post Office of Aubigny, in Manitoba, respecting the subdivision of certain lands within the Rural Municipality of Morris in the form and substance of the agreement hereto attached as Schedule A to this by-law.
2. That the proper officers of the Rural Municipality of Morris are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to execute the subject agreement in the normal manner and to place thereon the seal of the Municipality.
