

BY-LAW NO. 1152/81. *JH*

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris,
relative to the acquisition of certain lands.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris has been offered
the lands and premises hereinafter described, presently being used as a
skating rink in the Village of Lowe Farm, in Manitoba so that continuity
of title and for continued use of said lands and premises for the rate-
payers of the Municipality resident in the Lowe Farm area may be achieved;

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is prepared to
accept transfer of said lands and premises to itself to achieve the desired
objectives;

THEREFORE NOW be it and it is hereby enacted as a By-Law of the
Rural Municipality of Morris as follows:

1. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris accept a transfer of
the following described lands, namely:

"Being Lot Thirteen (13) as shown on a Plan of Survey of
part of the Village of Lowe Farm, in the Province of Manitoba
registered in the Morden Land Titles Office as No. 693;
excepting thereout all Mines and Minerals vested in the Crown
(Manitoba) by The Real Property Act."

from Peter Friesen, Grain Buyer, and Bernhard Braun, Contractor, both
of the Village of Lowe Farm, in Manitoba, at and for the nominal price
and sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration.

2. THAT the said lands and premises be acquired by the Municipality
and maintained for recreational purposes or other purposes beneficial to the
ratepayers of the Municipality resident in the Lowe Farm area in Manitoba.
