

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1179/81

BEING a by-law of the R. M. of Morris to authorize the execution of an agreement with the Department of Highways.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is installing sewer and water lines into the Village of Lowe Farm, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS in order to complete this installation these lines must cross Provincial Trunk Highway No. 23 and also go alongside of Provincial Road No. 332;

AND WHEREAS the Department of Highways requires that an agreement be entered into setting the conditions by which they shall allow this crossing and the placement of the line along of a provincial road;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris deems it expedient and necessary to implement this agreement;

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED the Rural Municipality of Morris, in Council duly assembled as follows:


1. That the Rural Municipality of Morris does now authorize the entering into an agreement with the Province of Manitoba Department of Highways for the purpose of allowing sewer and water lines to cross Provincial Trunk Highway No. 23 and to go alongside Provincial Road No. 332 and which agreement shall be considered as Schedule A to this by-law.
2. That the Reeve or Deputy-Reeve and the Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized to sign all necessary documents on behalf of the municipality in order to complete this agreement.
