

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1275/84

BEING a By-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to provide for the making of grants of money and the authorization of same.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, S.M. 1970, C100 - M225, Section 3 et seq., provides that the Council of any municipality may pass by-laws for making grants to certain organizations;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris deems it expedient and in the best interest of the corporation to make grants of money to certain organizations in the year 1983;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris duly assembled in open Council, enacts as follows:


1. That the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris be and is hereby authorized to make grants of money in the year 1983 to the organizations and in the amounts here under stated:
