

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1277/84

BEING a By-law authorizing a drainage agreement between the R. M. of Morris and the Rural Municipality of De Salaberry.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris does have certain drains which travel into the R. M. of De Salaberry;

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is of the opinion that certain work regarding these drains should be done on a shared basis between the R. M. of Morris and the R. M. of De Salaberry;

AND WHEREAS the R. M. of De Salaberry has agreed to this and an agreement has been reached regarding these drains;


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the R. M. of Morris agrees to enter into a drainage agreement with the R. M. of De Salaberry and that the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer are now authorized to sign the necessary agreement on behalf of the R. M. of Morris.
2. That the above mentioned drainage agreement shall now be annexed to and form part of this by-law as Schedule

THIS AGREEMENT MADE IN DUPLICATE THIS 14th DAY
OF FEBRUARY A.D., 1988.

BETWEEN: THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DE SALABERRY
of the first part

and

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS
of the second part

IN THE MATTER OF:

- 1) That drain running East, to the Marsh River,
midway through Section 7-6-3E;
- 2) That drain running East to the Marsh River,
South of Section 6-6-3E
- 3) That drain running East, North of Section 18-6-3E,
continuing North of, and in Section 17-6-3E to
the Marsh River;
- 4) That drain running East from the centre of West
Boundary of Section 6-6-3E to the Marsh River.

WHEREAS these drains described above serve to drain waters from
both the Rural Municipality of Morris and the Rural Municipality
of De Salaberry

AND WHEREAS there is consensus between both municipalities that
there should be a form of cost-sharing formula concerning works
to these drains;


NOW THEREFORE in consideration of the mutual covenants as here-
inafter contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:


All costs pertaining to those drains described herein, including those
incurred by both parties during 1983, shall be shared on a 50/50 cost-
sharing basis.

It is agreed that rates for machine work shall be 80% of current govern-
ment rates, charged on a 50/50 basis.


Work to any and all drains referred to in this agreement must be
