

BY-LAW NO. 1289/84

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the acquisition of certain property.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris requires for its purposes the following described lands:

"The most Easterly 50 feet in width of all that portion of River Lot 339 of the Parish of Ste. Agathe, in Manitoba, taken for a Public Lane as the same is shown on a plan of survey registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office, Morris Division, as No. 23, lying to the West of Main Street as the same is shown on said Plan which lies to the North of the Northern limit of Lot 207 and to the South of the Southern limit of Lot 244, which lots are shown on said Plan, except thereout all mines and minerals;"

AND WHEREAS the owner of said lands has accepted the offer made by the Rural Municipality of Morris with respect to the purchase of said lands;

AND WHEREAS the consideration is deemed fair and reasonable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED as a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in Council duly assembled as follows:

1. THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris purchase the following described lands:

"The most Easterly 50 feet in width of all that portion of River Lot 339 of the Parish of Ste. Agathe, in Manitoba, taken for a Public Lane as the same is shown on a plan of survey registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office, Morris Division, as No. 23, lying to the West of Main Street as the same is shown on said Plan which lies to the North of the Northern limit of Lot 207 and to the South of the Southern limit of Lot 244, which lots are shown on said Plan, except thereout all mines and minerals;"

from THE TOWN OF MORRIS, at and for the sum of ONE (\$1.00) DOLLAR, together with all of the vendor's legal fees and disbursements.

2. THAT the Reeve and the Secretary-Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to do all things necessary and required to give force and effect to this by-law.
