

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1294/84

WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris wishes to amend the Morris Planning Scheme 1968;

AND WHEREAS Section 95(2) of The Planning Act provides that a planning scheme may be amended;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it expedient and advisable to amend the Morris Planning Scheme 1968;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Mo-ris in a meeting duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. That the lands described as follows:

All that portion of the most Southerly 285 feet in perp. depth of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 28-4-1E.P.M. lying to the East of a line drawn Northerly parallel to the Western limit of said quarter section from a point in the Southern limit of said quarter section a distant Easterly thereon 519.75 feet from the said Western limit, which lies to the West of a line drawn Northerly at right angles to said Southern limit from a point in the same distant Easterly thereon 938.9 feet from the sa Western limit.

which parcel of land is currently zoned as "A40"

Rural District be hereby now zoned to that of "A"

Rural District as indicated by diagonal lines on Schedule "A" to this By-law.


2. That Appendix "A" of the Morris Planning Scheme 1971B

which is amending the District Map One of the Morris Planning Scheme 1968 be hereby amended in accordance to this By-law.

3. That the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to give for and effect to this By-law.
