

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1321/86

BEING a By-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris appointing an Enumerator, a Revising Officer and a Returning Officer for the Municipality.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 10(1) of the Local Authorities Election Act, the Council of each Local Authority shall, by by-law, not later than the fifteenth day of February, next following the coming into force of this Act, or next following application of this Act to the authority, appoint, and fix and provide for the remuneration of

- (a) an Enumerator
- (b) a Revising Officer
- (c) a Returning Officer

AND WHEREAS due to resignations, etc. it is necessary to upgrade the listing of the above mentioned officers;


NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the R. M. of Morris in Council duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. THAT Mrs. Anne Reimer, of Rosenort, Manitoba be appointed as Enumerator for the R. M. of Morris. That Mrs. Anne Reimer proceed to make a list of persons qualified to have their names placed on the list of electors as requested by the Municipality and in accordance to the regulations of the Local Authority Election Act.
That Mrs. Anne Reimer shall be paid for her duties in the making of the Elector's List for the Municipality and shall be paid a remuneration as may be stipulated for time to time by a resolution of Council.
2. THAT Mrs. Irma Bjarnason of Morris, Manitoba be appointed as Revising Officer for the Rural Municipality of Morris and shall perform the duties thereof as outlined in Section 19(1), (2) and (3) of the Local Authorities Election Act.
That Mrs. Irma Bjarnason shall be paid a remuneration as shall be stipulated by a resolution of Council.
3. THAT Section 19(4) of the Local Authorities Election Act provides that a municipality may reduce the number of days the revising officer shall sit for the purpose of revising the list. Therefore, the Rural Municipality of Morris does now hereby reduce the number of days the revising officer shall sit for the purpose of revising the list to one day only.
4. THAT Mr. Grant G. Macaulay, of Morris, Manitoba be appointed as Returning Officer for the Rural Municipality of Morris and perform the duties of the Returning Officer as outlined in the Local Authorities Election Act.
That for the performance of said duties as Returning Officer, Mr. Grant G. Macaulay shall be paid a remuneration as stipulated from time to time by a resolution of Council.
5. THAT By-law No. 1267/83 of the Rural Municipality of Morris is hereby now repealed.
