

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1372/89

BEING a By-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris authorizing the extension of the sewer and water system at Rosenort and the charging of a special rate against those properties affected.

WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris is of the opinion that the following project should be carried out as a local improvement pursuant to the provisions of Part XI of The Municipal Act:

Construction and installation of extensions to the low pressure sewage collection and disposal system and to the water distribution system at Rosenort to a total estimated cost of \$86,100.00, funded as follows:

- (a) a grant from the Province of Manitoba in the amount of \$25,830.00,
- (b) payment by property owners for service connections in the approximate amount of \$5,000.00.
- (c) from surplus operating funds of the present water utility in the amount of \$55,270.00;

AND WHEREAS the present sewer and water systems were constructed and installed pursuant to By-law No. 1170, which provided for the creation of debenture debt and levying of a frontage charge of One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per front foot and a special mill rate levy;

AND WHEREAS debentures were issued in accordance with amending By-laws numbers 1268 and 1280 which provided for such levies over a period of fifteen years;

AND WHEREAS Council is of the opinion that property owners served by the extension of the systems should be subject to the same levies until the said period has expired;

AND WHEREAS the requirements of Section 626 of the Municipal Act have been complied with;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris, duly assembled, enacts that:

1. The Rural Municipality of Morris shall proceed to construct and install extensions to the sewage collection and disposal system and to the water distribution system at Rosenort and to expend the sum of \$86,100.00 for the purpose.
2. Of the sum expended, the amount of \$55,270.00 shall be taken from the surplus operating funds of Local Improvement District No. 2, as approved by the Public Utilities Board under Order No. 22/89.
3. Of the sum expended, the approximate amount of \$5,000.00 shall be charged to property owners for service connections.
4. Each property owner shall pay the estimated actual cost of service connection in cash in advance. The cost of any service connection not paid for in full shall be a lien and charged on the land and shall be added to the tax roll under Section 573 of the Act.



5. (a) In each of the years 1990 to 1998 inclusive, there shall be raised annually by a special rate of \$1.50 per foot on the property described in Schedule "A" hereto and in accordance therewith, a sum which shall be applied to the principal and interest requirements of the debentures issued pursuant to By-law Nos. 1268 and 1280 during their currency.

(b) During the currency of the debentures provided for under By-law Nos. 1268 and 1280, there shall be raised annually by a special rate on all the property described in Schedule "A" hereto an amount which together with the amounts raised under By-law No. 1170, is sufficient to meet the balance of the principal and interest requirements of said debentures.
