BY-LAW NO. 1374/89

WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris wishes to amend the Morris Planning Scheme 1968;

AND WHEREAS Section 93(1) of The Planning Act provides that a planning scheme may be amended;


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris deems it expedient and advisable to amend the Morris Planning Scheme 1968;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris in a meeting duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. That Section D3A.1.1 Conditional Uses of the Morris Planning Scheme 1968, as amended, is further amended by adding thereto, immediately at the end thereof, the following:
Garbage Disposal Sites
Sewage Disposal Sites
2. That the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to this By-law


I, Grant G. Macaulay, Secretary-Treasurer of the Rural Municipality

do solemnly declare that


1. I am the Secretary-Treasurer of the Rural Municipality of Morris.
