

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1379/90

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris has a by-law which authorizes the provision of Municipal assistance to persons in need;

AND WHEREAS this By-law No. 1290/84 has a Schedule "A" which provides the rates by which the Municipality is to provide such Municipal assistance;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris wishes to amend clauses (a) to (d) inclusive of Schedule "A" of By-law No. 1290/87;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED as a By-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris as follows:

1. That clauses (a) to (d) inclusive of Schedule "A" of By-law No. 1290/84 be now amended to read as follows:

(a) For Food, but subject ot Note 1 of this clause:

- (i) Each Adult \$93.60 per month
- (ii) Each person 21 to 17 years of age \$104.00 per month
- (iii) Each person 7 to 11 years of age \$85.45 per month
- (iv) Each person from birth to 6 years of age ... \$61.95 per month

NOTE 1 Whereas the household unit consists of three or less beneficiaries, the following additions shall be made.

- (v) For a single person \$18.75 per month
- (vi) For each of two persons \$8.95 per month
- (vii) For each of three persons \$4.40 per month

(b) For Clothing, but subject ot Notes 1 and 2 of this clause:

- (i) Each Adult \$24.55 per month
- (ii) Each person 12 to 17 years of age \$31.35 per month
- (iii) Each person 7 to 11 years of age \$20.90 per month
- (iv) Each person form birth to 6 years of age ... \$20.90 per month

NOTE 1 Each child not living with his own family, the actual cost as required and authorized by the municipality

NOTE 2 For each employed adult an amount of \$14.10 per month may be added.

(c) For Personal Needs for adult recipients:

- (i) When the household consists of a single beneficiary \$41.05 per month
- (ii) When the household consists of more than one beneficiary \$30.50 per month
- (iii) For a patient in hospital or other prescribed institute \$20.55 per month

(d) For Household Supplies:

- (i) For each household unit \$8.15 per month
- (ii) For each person in a household unit after the first \$2.75 per month

2. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date it receives the approval of Council and that By-law No. 1340/87 shall be hereby now rescinded.
