

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1388/90

BEING a By-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris for the purpose of recognizing and granting holidays and statutory holidays for Municipal Employees.

WHEREAS the Government of Manitoba and the Government of Canada have established and declared that certain days be recognized as statutory holidays and holidays for employees;

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris hereby recognizes these holidays;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris wishes to establish these holidays for the employees of the R. M. of Morris;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Rural Municipality of Morris, in Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the following days be recognized as statutory holidays for employees of the Rural Municipality of Morris:


New Years Day	January 1
Good Friday	
Victoria Day	
Canada Day	July 1
August Civic Holiday	
Labor Day	
Thanksgiving Day	
Christmas Day	December 25
Boxing Day	December 26

2. That the following day shall be recognized as a holiday for employees of the Rural Municipality of Morris provided that the said date of the holiday falls on a normal work day for that employee:

Remembrance Day	November 11
