

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1435/93

BEING a By-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to provide the granting of municipal assistance to persons in need and to repeal By-law No. 1290/84 and By-law No. 1379/90.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, C.C.S.M. c. M225, as amended by The Social Allowances Amendment and Consequential Amendmetns Act, S.M. 1992, c.30 requires municipalities to provide municipal assistance in accordance with The Social Allowances Act, C.C.S.M. c.S160, as amended by The Social Allowances Amendment and Consequential Amendments Act, S.M. 1992, c.30 and the Municipal Assistance Regulation;

AND WHEREAS The Municipal Act, C.C.S.M. c. M225, as amended by The Social Allowances Amendment and Consequential Amendmetns Act, S.M. 1992, c.30 provides that a municipalti may by by-law provide for the granting of an amount of municipal assistance that is greater than that which would otherwise be payable under The Social Allowances Act, C.C.S.M. c.S160, as amended by The Social Allowances Amendment and Consequential amendemtns Act, S.M. 1992, c.30;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Assistance Regulation, being Regulation Number 191/92 registered October 16, 1992 requires that each municipality shall make a by-law designating the position of those municipal employees who are authorized to administer municipal assistance;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Assistance Regulation entitles a municipality to Provincial cost sharing for any resulting increase in the cost of municipal assistance where the municipality has, by by-law, established a liquid asset exemption for recipients not exceeding \$400.00 per person, to a maximum exemption of \$2,000.00 per household;


AND WHEREAS the Municipal Assistance Regulation entitles a municipality to Provincial cost sharing for any resulting increase in the cost of municipal assistance where the municipality has, by by-law, established an exemption from the earned income of applicants and/or recipients, which exemption is shareable by the Government of Canada under the terms of the Canada Assistance Plan;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris, in regular session assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. This by-law may be referred to as the "Rural Municipality of Morris Municipal Assistance By-law".
2. The employee designated to administer municipal assistance in the Rural Municipality of Morris is the employee who occupies the position of Secretary-Treasurer for the Rural Municipality of Morris.
3. That By-law No. 1290/84 and By-law No. 1379/90 of the Rural Municipality of Morris are hereby repealed.
4. That this by-law shall come into force on April 1, 1993.
