

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1459/94

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to alter the boundaries of a hospital district,

WHEREAS Section 65(1) of the Health Services Act, R.S.M. 1987, cap H30 provides as follows:

Where a supplementary scheme altering the boundaries of a district by adding territory thereto or subtracting territory therefrom has been prepared and has been approved by a resolution of the board of the district, by a resolution of the board of any other district affected by the proposed alteration, and by a by-law of each municipality in which any part of the territory to be added or subtracted is situated, the minister may, by regulation, alter the boundaries of the district accordingly.

AND WHEREAS certain land of the Altona Hospital District is located within the Rural Municipality of Morris;

AND WHEREAS the boundaries of the Red River Valley Health District and the Altona Health District are to be varied by subtracting from the Altona Health District and adding to the Red River Valley Health District all of the land within the Rural Municipality of Morris which is presently in the Altona Health District;

NOW THEREFORE be it and it is hereby enacted as a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris as follows:

1. **THAT** the Rural Municipality of Morris approve the alteration of the boundaries of the Altona Health District and the Red River Valley Health District by transferring from the Altona Health District to the Red River Valley Health District the following described land:

Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5-4-2 WPM, and Sections 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6-4-1 WPM.

2. **THAT** the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to do all things and execute all documents and attach the seal of the Municipality to all documents necessary to carry out the provisions of this by-law.
