

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1481/95

BEING a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to establish a new bulk water rate within the said Rosenort Local Improvement District.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris owns and operates a water and sewer utility facility with the limits of the said urban centre of Rosenort;

AND WHEREAS this water and sewer system for Rosenort has been in operation since 1983;

AND WHEREAS Council feels it necessary that the commodity rates for bulk water at Rosenort be increased;

AND WHEREAS Section 647 (2) of The Municipal Act states as follows:

"Subject to the approval of The Public Utilities Board as to the price charged as hereinafter provided, the council of any municipality, for itself or on behalf of a local improvement district, may pass by-laws fixing the price that any owner or occupant of land shall pay for using water of the municipality obtained from a water system or from pumps, taps, or pipes, established by the municipality."


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Rural Municipality of Morris, in Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule "A" of By-law No. 1311/85 be now amended as follows:
"3. Bulk Sales Rate
All water sold in bulk by the Rosenort Local Improvement shall be charged for at the rate of \$1.32 per cubic meter."
2. That this by-law is amending the rates imposed under By-law No. 1311/85. Therefore, all rates and regulations not amended by this by-law shall remain in force and effect and that this by-law only amends that area of By-law 1311/85 as stated under Clause No. 1 of this By-law.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and effect after the approval by the Public Utilities Board and receipt of third and final reading thereof.



BULK SALES RATE:

$$\frac{\text{M\&O } \$52,357.48 \text{ plus debenture costs } \$47,811.47}{\text{M\&O } \$52,357.48} \times \$0.74 = \$2.70/\text{m}$$

NOTE: REQUESTS BULK WATER RATE OF \$1.32/m

The Bulk water rate at Lowe Farm is \$1.32/m and at Morris the rate is approximately \$1.16/m . The calculated rate of \$2.70/m makes it unrealistic for competitive reasons and we wish to propose a rate of \$1.32/m to be the same as our Lowe Farm Utility and to be slightly higher but still competitive with the Morris water rate.
