

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1494/96

BEING a By-law to designate Purple Loosestrife  
(Common Name) in the Morris-Montcalm Weed  
District as a Local Weed.

WHEREAS the Weed Control Act, authorizes the Council of a  
Municipality, by By-law, to designate Purple Loosestrife as a local weed  
in respect of the whole or any part of the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS any of these plant species designated as local weeds  
shall be deemed to be noxious;

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris has complied with  
the Manitoba Noxious Weed Act;

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is a member of the  
Morris-Montcalm Weed Control District;

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris wishes to designate  
Purple Loosestrife (Lythrum) as a local weed in the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris  
enacts as follows:

1. That the following weed be and is hereby designated as a local weed  
in the whole of the Rural Municipality of Morris:

<u>COMMON NAME</u>	<u>SCIENTIFIC NAME</u>
Purple Loosestrife	Lythrum spp**

2. That the entire Lythrum family be declared noxious, including all hybrids  
developed for ornamental purposes.

3. That this By-law shall not come into force and take effect until it  
has been approved by the Minister of Agriculture.
