

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 1519/98

BEING a By-law of The Rural Municipality of Morris providing for the naming of various highways and roads in the said municipality and affixing such names at the corners thereof, of either public or private property.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provision of The Municipal Act, subsection 232(1)(d), the council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting municipal roads, including naming the roads, posting the names on public or private property, and numbering lots and buildings along the roads;

AND WHEREAS it is required that such a road naming by-law be registered at the respective land titles district in which the highway or road is situated;


AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris intends to affix or cause to be affixed the appropriate names at the corners of all provincial roads and truck highways in the said municipality, on either public or private property;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris in regular session assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That all highways situated in the Rural Municipality of Morris be and are hereby identified as set out in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this by-law.
2. That the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris is hereby authorized to affix the appropriate identifications at the corners of all provincial roads and truck highways, on either public or private property.
3. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect on and from the date on which it is registered in the Morden Land Titles Office and the Winnipeg Land Titles Office in the Province of Manitoba.

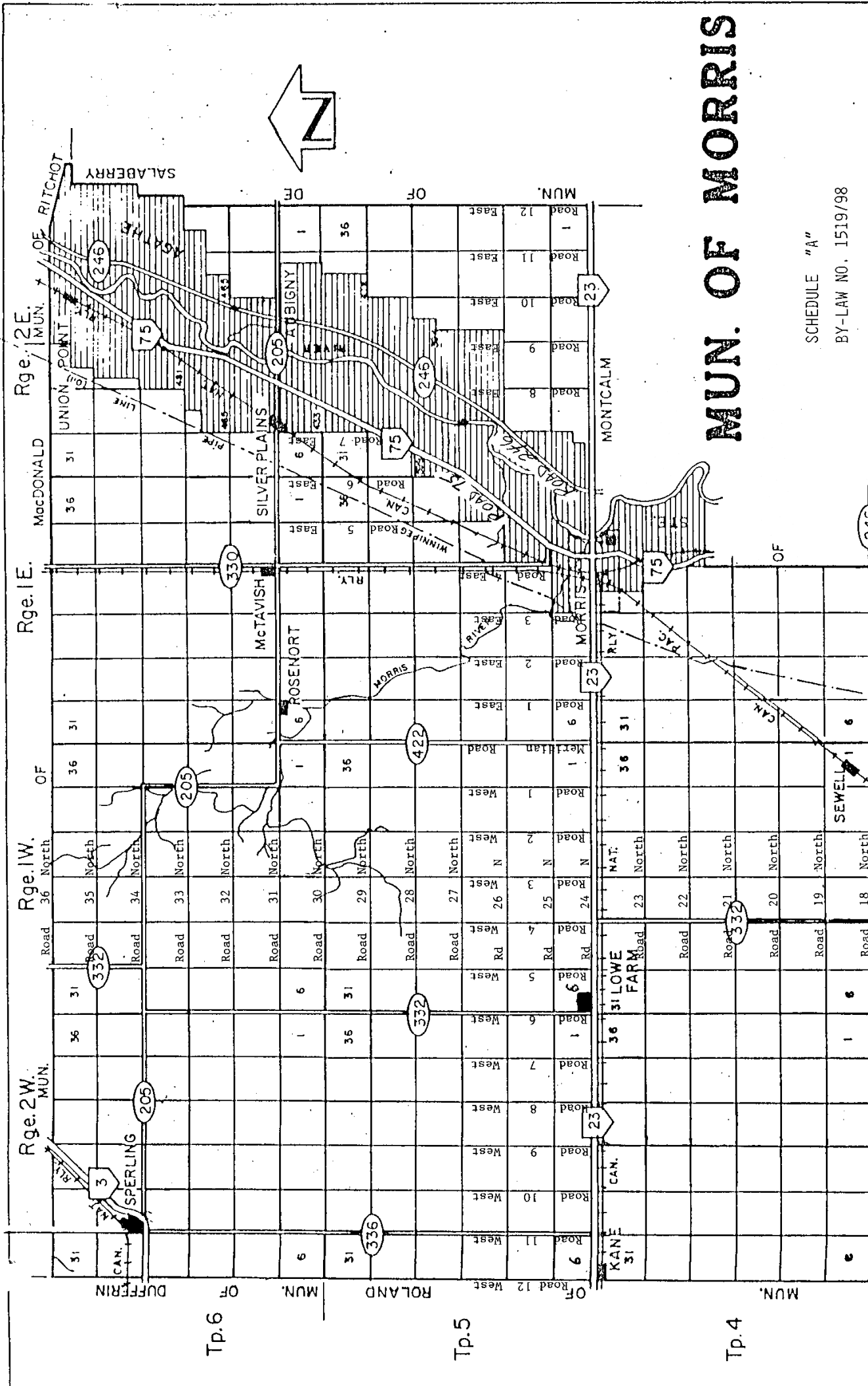
