BY-LAW NO. 1602-06

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to establish a gas tax reserve fund.

WHEREAS subsection 168(1) of The Municipal Act provides as follows:

“A council may by by-law establish reserve funds for any general or specific purpose”

AND WHEREAS the Council of the R.M. of Morris believes that it is in the best interest of the Municipality to establish a gas tax reserve fund.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the R.M. of Morris enacts as follows:

1. THAT a Gas Tax Reserve fund be established.
2. THAT this is a specific purpose reserve established for the purpose of holding federal gas tax funds to pay eligible costs of eligible projects.
