

**The Rural Municipality of Morris**

BY-LAW NO. 1623-08

**BEING** a By-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris  
To Amend RM of Morris Development Plan By-law No.1580/04 As Amended.

**WHEREAS**, Section 56 of The Planning Act gives the Board or Council the power to amend an adopted Development Plan;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the RM of Morris, in meeting duly assembled enacts as follows:

**Delete** Policy 3.3.10 b) and replace with the following new policy:

- b) a mutual separation distance will be maintained between major livestock production operations and residences not accessory to the operation. These mutual separation distances will be established in the Zoning By-Law. The minimum separation distances will reflect provincial standards for smaller operations and become incrementally larger, up to over 2.5 times the provincial standard, for the larger operations. Council may, pursuant to Section 169 (4) of *The Planning Act*, vary the separation distance provided in the Zoning By-Law. Additionally, all livestock operators must be generally consistent with the siting and setback requirements from property lines, designated development areas, watercourses and wells as outlined in the Provincial Land Use Policies, Farm Practices Guidelines and the Manure Management and Mortalities Regulation of *The Environment Act*;

AND

**Delete** Policy 3.3.10 d) and renumber Policy 3.3.10 e) accordingly.
