

By - Law No. 552

By-Law No. 552 of the Rural Municipality of Morris being a by-law for the purpose of raising a Municipal Levy for the year 1935; One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty Five, and levying for that purpose all necessary rates and to regulate the expenditure thereof.

Whereas the Assessment Roll for the Rural Municipality of Morris for the year 1935 has been revised in accordance with the statutes and the total property in the said Municipality subject to taxation according to the said Assessment Roll is \$3,581,000.00

And Whereas there will be required to provide for the necessary expenses of the said Municipality and for the payment of all such sums of monies as the said Municipality has undertaken to pay or is liable to pay during the year 1935, amounting to approximately \$70,000.00 which sum must be levied on all taxable property within the said Municipality of Morris.

And Whereas there will be required for school purposes during the said year of 1935 to be levied on all taxable property within the said Municipality the sum of \$16,707.70 for general levy as required by the following mentioned School Districts.

New Kennedy, Osborne, St. Antoine, St. Elizabeth, St. Martens, St. Jean Baptiste North, St. Jean Baptiste Centre, St. Jean Baptiste West, Kane, Melba, De Wet, and Morris,

The proportion of the said Municipality of Morris of the expense thereof for the year 1935, and the special levy to be made by the Municipality of Morris is as follows,

And Whereas the sum of \$10,331.06 is required by the Municipal Commissioner for the year 1935, and it is necessary to levy for the said amount.

And Whereas it is necessary to levy and raise the amount of \$4,359.23 as payment of principal and interest due on the \$50,000.00 issue of Good Roads Debentures, issued under authority of the Good Roads Act.

And Whereas it is necessary and expedient to raise the sum of \$1,255.00 as payment of principal and interest due on the \$13,697.00 issue of the Morris Bridge Debentures issued under authority of the Morris Bridge Act.

And Whereas it is expedient and necessary to raise the sum of \$2,510.00 as payment of principal and interest due on the \$27,607.18 issue of the Morris Bridge Debentures issued under authority of the Morris Bridge Act. This levy applies only to that portion of the Municipality known as the Morris Bridge District.

And Whereas it is expedient and necessary that the sum of upwards of \$21,486.00 be raised for public improvements such as grading, ditching, levelling roads, building bridges, and keeping same in repair.

And Whereas it is expedient and necessary that provision should be made to raise the sums for these and other purposes respectively and to provide for the manner in which the said sums of money shall be expended.

Now therefor the Council of the Rural Municipality enacts as follows,

There shall be levied for the purpose of raising a Municipal Revenue for the Rural Municipality of Morris for the year 1935, a tax or taxes on all real and personal property liable for taxation as appears on the assessment Roll of the said year for the following purposes,

That is to say,

For the purpose of the general necessary expenses of the Municipality, for the purpose of paying the amount required by the Municipal Commissioner, and paying the amount as required as general school tax a rate of 8 mills on the dollar.

For the purpose of paying \$4,359.23 due February 1st. 1936 on the \$50,000.00 Debenture issue (Good Roads) a rate of 1.5 mills on the dollar. For the purpose of paying \$1,255.00 due November 1st. 1935 on the Morris Bridge Debentures a rate of .5 mills on the dollar.

For the purpose of paying \$2,510.00 due November 1st. 1935, on the Morris Red River Bridge Debentures issued under authority of the Morris Bridge Act, a rate of 13½ cents per acre. This Levy applies only to that portion of the Municipality lying east of the Red River in the Morris Bridge District.

For the purpose of paying the amount required for Public Works a rate of 6 mills on the dollar.

There shall be levied on all property liable for taxation for School purposes, within the districts herein mentioned the following rates,

And there shall be levied upon the Local Improvement District of Sperling the sum of \$600.00 to pay the cost of Street Lighting. And there shall be levied the amount necessary to take care of the deficit if any, in the operation of the Community Rink at Sperling.

And there shall be levied and collected the amounts required by the Minister of Public Works as provided in the Statutes in that behalf for Drainage Districts No. 2, 6, and 12.

The above rates and taxes hereby authorized when and as they shall be collected be applied as follows.

In payment of Debentures and interest on the \$27,607.18 Morris Bridge Debenture issue the sum of \$2,510.00

In payment of Debenture and interest Morris Bridge Debenture on the \$13,697.00 issue the sum of \$1,255.00

In payment of Debenture and interest on the \$50,000.00 Good Roads Debenture issue for one year the sum of \$4,359.23

In payment of the annual amount to the Manitoba Power Commission, Re. Street Lights in the Village of Sperling.

In payment of deficit if any in connection with the operation of the Sperling Community Rink.

In payment of the amounts required by the Trustees of the following School ~~Districts~~ Districts,

And the balance in payment of the general expenses and other liabilities of the Rural Municipality of Morris as the Council thereof shall from time to time by by-law or resolution authorize.

These taxes and rates hereby imposed shall be considered to have been imposed and to become payable on or before the 31st. day of October A.D. 1935.

Upon all taxes or rates remaining unpaid after that date when same are due and payable, there shall be added on the first day of each month thereafter as a penalty an additional sum amounting to three-fourths of one per centum of such taxes or rates until paid or until the Municipality has sold the property liable therefor at Tax Sale.
