

By-Law No. 557 of the Rural Municipality of Morris, authorizing
the sale and transfer of Lots 6 and 7, Block 5, Plan 522

Village of Lowe Farm

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is the
owner of the following lots, namely, Six (6) and Seven (7)
in Block Five (5) Plan Five Hundred and Twenty-two (522)
of the Village of Lowe Farm, having acquired the said lots
by tax sale proceedings.

AND WHEREAS Edward Groening has offered to purchase
the said lots for the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) in cash
and it is deemed advisable to accept this offer.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted as By-Law No.
of the Rural Municipality of Morris that the offer of Edward
Groening of the Village of Lowe Farm in the Province of
Manitoba, Farmer, to purchase Lots Six (6) and Seven (7)
in Block Five (5) according to a Plan of Survey of part of
the Village of Lowe Farm in Manitoba, registered in the
Morden Land Titles Office as No. 522 for the sum of Fifty
Dollars (\$50.00) be and is hereby accepted and that the
Reeve and Secretary-treasurer be authorized to execute the
necessary conveyance to complete the sale of the said property.
