

By-Law No. *560* of the Rural Municipality of Morris authorizing
the Assignment of Tax Sale Certificate No. 58,
covering Lots 29 & 30, Block 4, Plan 916, Sperling

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris did purchase
at the 1931 tax sale of the said municipality, the following
land, namely, Lots Twenty-nine (29) and Thirty (30) in Block
Four (4) according to a Plan of Survey of part of the Village
of Sperling registered in the Carman Land Titles Office as
No. 916, and Tax Sale Certificate No. 38, dated the 25th day
of November 1931, was issued in respect thereof.

AND WHEREAS Violet McNulty of the Village of Sperling
in the Province of Manitoba, wife of Cornelius B. McNulty of
the same place, Agent, has applied for an assignment of the
said Tax Sale Certificate and the proceedings taken thereunder.

AND WHEREAS the said Violet McNulty has paid to the
Municipality the amount for which the said land was sold
together with all penalties and subsequent costs in connection
with the said certificate and application for title.

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted as By-Law No.
of the Rural Municipality of Morris, that it assign, transfer
and set over unto the said Violet McNulty, all its right, title
and interest in and to the said Tax Sale Certificate, and the
proceedings taken thereunder and that the Reeve and Secretary
Treasurer be authorized to sign and seal the necessary Assignment.

PASSED and enacted as a By-Law of the Rural Municipality
of Morris, at a meeting of the Council of the said Municipality
held on the day of October A. D. 1935.
