

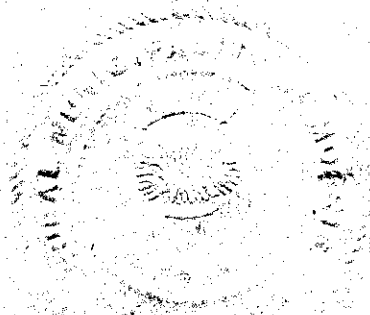
Bylaw No. 562 of The Rural Municipality of Morris
authorizing the sale of S. W. 15-6-1-West.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is the owner of the following lands, namely, the South West Quarter of Section Fifteen (15) in Township Six (6) and Range One (1) West of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Manitoba, having acquired the said land by tax sale proceedings;

AND WHEREAS Walter L. Baker of the Post Office of Lowe Farm in the Province of Manitoba has offered to purchase the said property for the sum of Sixteen hundred (\$1600.00) Dollars, payable Two hundred ^{and fifty} (~~\$250.00~~) Dollars in cash and Two hundred Dollars (\$200.00) on the First day of November A.D. 1936 and the balance in three equal annual payments on the First day of November in each of the years 1937, 1938 and 1939 and it is advisable to accept this offer.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted as Bylaw No. 662 of the Rural Municipality of Morris that the offer of Walter L. Baker to purchase the South West Quarter of Section Fifteen (15) in Township Six (6) and Range One (1) West of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba for the sum of Sixteen hundred (\$1600.00) be and is hereby accepted and that the Reeve and Secretary Treasurer be authorized to enter into a formal Agreement for Sale of said land, the purchaser to pay taxes from and after December 31st 1935 and to pay interest on the unpaid purchase price from the First day of November A. D. 1935.
